

How to install a driver for a SummaCut R(L)



Introduction

This document describes how to install the software necessary to drive the SummaCut R(L) series roll-cutter.

Note: We do not work with a 'Windows based printer driver'.

A **design software** is needed to create a design. Popular design programs are CorelDRAW, Adobe Illustrator, Inkscape, ... Design software is not supplied from Summa.

The contours in the job created with one of those design software's need to be sent to the cutter. Before the contours can be sent, the contours need to be converted in commands understood by the cutter (DM/PL commands). This is accomplished by the software <u>WinPlot</u>. WinPlot then needs to send the commands to the cutter using a communication port. Depending on the communication interfaces available, and/or the interface used to drive the cutter, different <u>driver software</u> needs to be installed.

Transferring the job from the design software to the cutting software can be done by means of a **<u>plug-in</u>**.

USB Driver install

To be able to use the USB interface, a USB driver needs to be installed. This driver is available from the support page of the Summa website:



Download the USB driver. Double click on the downloaded driver to start the install process. Follow the install wizard to complete the install.

In the software driving the machine, the communication port used to send the data to the cutter needs to be set to the USB port.

Serial Interface



When the cutter is connected using the serial interface, you do not need a driver, you have to set the correct settings in the cutting software.



Using a serial to USB adapter



In case the cutter is connected to the computer using a USB-RS232 adapter, the USB driver for this adapter needs to be installed (and not the one from Summa), and in the software driving the cutter, the serial port this adapter is emulating should be selected. You will also need to use the serial cable delivered with the machine (reference 423-183) to connect the adapter to the cutter.

Serial interface cable wiring



The serial interface cable reference 423-183 is wired as in below table:


Procedure to determine serial port emulation of the adapter

Press and hold






Enter the text "devmgmt.msc" in the dialog box:



This opens the Device Manager.

Open the branch "Ports (COM & LPT)".

Check for the entry representing the USB to RS232 adapter. This entry displays the communication port this adapter is emulating. This communication port needs to be used in the application driving the machine.



Serial Port Configuration of the Cutter

It is not necessary to load media in the cutter to change the parameters.

Use the below steps to change the serial port configuration of the cutter:



- Power on the cutter.
- Press . *'KNIFE PRESSURE' will appear on the LCD.*
- Press

'SYSTEM SETUP' will appear on the LCD.

- Press . *ACTIONS' will appear on the LCD.*
- Press or until 'CONFIGURATION' is reached.
- Press

'LANGUAGE' will be displayed.

- Use \checkmark to scroll through the menu until 'BAUDRATE' is reached.
- Press

*"*9600" will now appear on the LCD. Note the value may be different depending on the current speed the baud rate was set.*

- Press or to change the baud rate to the desired speed. Available options are: 2400, 4800, 9600, 19200, 38400, 57600.
- Press to confirm.
 An '*' will appear in front of the value indicating the new active value.
- Press
- Press v to set the parity parameter. *'PARITY' will appear on the LCD.*
- Press

*"*NONE" will appear on the LCD. Note this may be different depending on the previously selected parity setting.*

Press or to change the parity setting. Available options are: NONE, MARK, EVEN, ODD.



• Press to confirm.

An '*' will appear in front of the value indicating the new active value.


- Press
- Press v to set the handshake parameter. *RTS/DTR' will appear on the LCD.*
 - Press . *"*TOGGLE" will appear on the LCD. Note this may be different depending on the previously selected handshake setting.*
- Press or to change the handshake setting. Available options are: TOGGLE, ALWAYS HIGH.
- Press to confirm.
 An '*' will appear in front of the value indicating the new active value.
- Press twice to return to set the machine back online.

Available serial communication parameters:

- BAUD RATE: 2400, 4800, *9600, 19200, 38400
- PARITY: *NONE, MARK, EVEN, ODD
- RTS/DTS: *TOGGLE, HIGH

The * indicates the default values.

Network Interface





When the cutter is connected using the network interface, you do not need a driver, you have to set the correct settings in the cutting software.

Network Configuration of the Cutter

It is not necessary to load media in the cutter to change the parameters.

Use the below steps to change the network parameters of the cutter:

- Power on the cutter.
- Press 'KNIFE PRESSURE' will appear on the LCD.
- Press 'SYSTEM SETUP' will appear on the LCD.
- Press 'ACTIONS' will appear on the LCD.
- until 'CONFIGURATION' is reached. Press
- Press 'IP CONFIG' will be displayed.
- Press "*DHCP' or "*STATIC' will be displayed.
- to select between a static IP address or a dynamic IP address. A static IP Press address is preferred to prevent the IP address of the cutter to change due to the DHCP server lease time settings.
- to confirm the selection. A * will proceed the selection to indicate the preferred Press method.

When DHCP was selected, then press twice to return to set the machine back online.

to select the IP address. Press



• Press to change the IP address. Press or to select the digit to change, press

to change the digit until the desired IP address is set.

- Press V to select the subnet mask.
- Press to change the subnet mask. Press \bigcirc or \bigcirc to select the digit to change,



 \checkmark to change the digit until the desired subnet mask is set.

• Press twice to return to set the machine back online.



WinPlot



From Windows Vista on, we work with a program called *WinPlot*.

This program can import EPS, AI and PDF files and then send data to the cutter. Most design programs are able to generate files in one of those formats.

We do not work with a 'Windows based printer driver'.

The program *WinPlot* can be downloaded from the Summa support website: https://www.summa.com/en/support/software-firmware/

This program works as a 'cutter driver', and converts the design created and exported in EPS, AI or PDF format in commands understood by the cutter.

To configure *WinPlot* for use of the USB interface with a Summa Cutter do the following:

• In the *Communication Setup* dialog set the options as in the picture below: in the Communication Port drop down box, select USB.

Serial Port

To configure *WinPlot* for use of a serial port with a Summa Cutter do the following:

In the *Communication Setup* dialog set the options as in the picture below.
 Select the serial port to which the cutter is connected to, e.g. COM5, from the Communication Port drop down box.
 By default, Summa Cutters are configured as follows:
 Baudrate : 9600
 Parity : None
 Data Bits : 8
 Stop Bits : Two
 Flow Control : RTS/CTS
 The serial port parameters (RS232 Port Settings) should match the configuration

Once the plug-in is installed, the design can be sent to WinPlot from the toolbar (CorelDRAW) or from the File submenu (Adobe Illustrator):



CorelDRAW

Four options are available:

- Add OPOS registration marks around the design
- Send the complete design to WinPlot
- Send only the selected objects to WinPlot
- Export the design to the AI format This option can be used when WinPlot is not installed on the computer used to create the design.

Three options are available:

- Add OPOS registration marks around the design
- Send the complete design to WinPlot
- Send only the selected objects to WinPlot




Summa Cutter Control 4

The Summa Cutter Control program basically has the same functions as the control panel.

The program Summa Cutter Control 4 (Legacy) can used to:

- Control all parameters of the cutter.
- Create and restore a backup containing all configurations of the cutter.
- Media length calibration to compensate for different media types.
- Perform tests.
- Adjust media sensor sensitivity.
- Send files to the cutter.
- Upgrade the firmware of the cutter.
- Work as a barcode server.






Install Summa Cutter Tools, then run Summa Cutter Tools, finally click the [Install] button to install Summa Cutter Control 4:




Before the program can be used, the communication interface needs to be selected and configured to match the connection type (USB or Network).
